

Sundial Creators Donate Original Drawings and History to University Archives

The sundial stands in front of Thwing Center on Euclid Avenue and has kept time for the last 25 years.

The time piece was gifted to the university in 1983 to commemorate the 10th anniversary of the campus group. About 5 years ago, the sundial had a major overhaul and was cleaned and repaired by the same three mentioned above. It was re-presented and re-mounted at that time.
